EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT

Youth participating in Purpose Place will have a comfortable space to engage in their online course work during the school day including breakfast, lunch and an in-person educational mentor, virtual tutor, and teaching artist there to assist, guide and motivate. Youth explore and develop new and interesting ways to achieve educational success.

PEER LEADERSHIP

Teens learn to lead with the opportunity to become peer mentors, youth advisory members with monetary stipends. Youth share knowledge to strengthen young people's ability to make informed decisions and to pass on what they learn to their peers.

ARTS AS ENRICHMENT

Youth work with professional artists to enhance their artistic voice; acquire cultural literacy, gain industry knowledge, and most importantly, develop their ability to articulate their experiences through art. Fine arts instruction, multimedia production, and performing arts program includes Hear This Poetry school-based clubs, Hampton Roads Youth Poets (HRYP), Youth Poet Laureate Program.

AdventuroUS & HIPTern

AdventuroUS Spatial Distancing Experience has a strong peer-led staff along with caring, trained adults. Programs include garden art; performance stage; small community festivals; outdoor games and learning stations where youth build resilience, gain positive values and social competency. HIPTern is a paid internship where teens are role models that produce food for the community and care for the garden at Purpose Park.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Youth have the opportunity to succeed, influence others, partake in social justice work, volunteerism and various arts and humanities programs that culminate in a public performance or exhibition and acquire community service hours.
