EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT & EMPOWERMENT FOR TEENS

Youth participating in Purpose Place will have a comfortable space to engage in their online course work during the school day including meals and a Student/Teach/Parent Support team, an on-site/virtual tutor, and teaching artist there to assist, guide and motivate. Youth explore and develop new and interesting ways to achieve educational success. School year program



PEER LEADERSHIP

Youth have the opportunity to succeed, influence others, partake in social justice work, volunteerism and various arts and humanities programs.

ARTS AS ENRICHMENT

Youth work with professional artists to enhance their artistic voice; Fine arts instruction, multimedia production, and performing arts program includes Poetry school-based clubs, Hampton Roads Youth Poets (HRYP), Youth Poet Laureate Program & Visual Arts.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Teens learn to lead with the opportunity to become peer mentors, some youth will earn incentives. Youth share knowledge with each other to strengthen young people's ability to make informed decisions.

AdventuroUS & HIPTern

AdventuroUS Spatial Distancing Experience has a strong peer-led staff along with caring, trained adults. Youth build resilience, gain positive values and social competency. HIPtern is a paid internship where teens are role models that produce food for the community and care for the garden at Purpose Park.
